KUALA LUMPUR (10 August) – CyberSecurity Malaysia, the National cyber security specialist centre and an agency under the Ministry of Science, Technology and Innovation (MOSTI), will be organizing the **Cyber Security Malaysia Awards, Conference and Exhibition 2010 (CSM-ACE)** from **25 to 29 October 2010**. Event will be held at the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre.

Col.
